### Daniel Carpenter, Massachusetts, A019404

- Private
- Residence: Wilbraham Hampshire Co MA
- Born: 25 May 1749, Hampshire Co MA
- Died: 25 Sep 1811, Pittsford Rutland Co VT

On 21 Nov 1775 in Leicester MA, Daniel married Lucy Nichols (b 22 Feb 1756 Leicester MA, d 11 Aug 1791 Pittsford Rutland Co VT). They were early settlers in Ladd Hollow. As of Winter 2021, DAR recognizes daughters from their children: Polly, John, and Lucy.

- Polly (b 27 Nov 1776 South Wilbraham MA, d 12 Nov 1863 Pittsford VT) married on 9 Mar 1795 at Pittsford VT to Richard Montgomery Powers (b 26 Dec 1775 Greenwich MA, d 25 Feb 1848 Pittsford VT).
- John (b 18 Sep 1778 Wilbraham Hampshire Co MA, d 26 Sep 1844 Tompkins Delaware Co NY) married Dolathair T Blakesley (b 2 Aug 1782 Suffield Hartford Co CT, d 5 Oct 1863 Earlville Delaware Co IA).
- Artemus (b 1782)
- Lucy (c 1783 VT, d 8 Apr 1863 Rutland Co VT) married Justus Powers (b 28 Feb 1774 VT, d 2 Jan 1826 Rutland Co VT).
- Daniel (b 20 Apr 1785)
- Caleb

As a Private, Daniel responded to the Lexington Alarm of April 18, 1775, serving nine days with Capt. Paul Langdon's Co which took him to the beginning of the siege of Boston. Daniel enlisted into the army 29 Apr 1775.

Daniel also served in Capt. Langdon's Co Col Timothy Danielson's regiment for three months ten days from muster roll dated 1 Aug 1775 to a return date of Oct 6, 1775. On 25 Dec 1775 he received an order for a bounty coat or its equivalent in money from Roxbury.
