Daniel Martin, Massachusetts, A205580

- Private
- Residence: Attleborough, Bristol Co MA
- Born: 24 Mar 1754, Rehoboth Bristol Co MA
- Died: Mar 1801, Attleborough Bristol Co MA

Daniel was baptized on 7 Apr 1754. He married either on 16 Sep 1780 (Family Search) or 1 Oct 1780 (GRS) to Judeth Bliss (b 14 Mar 1761 Rehoboth Bristol Co MA d p1 Mar 1825 Bristol Co MA). Daniel was the son of Robert and Elizabeth Martin.

As of summer 2021, one son, Daniel, has proven DAR daughters.

Daniel (b 14 Jan 1781 at Rehoboth Bristol Co MA d 3 Sep 1849 Pawtucket Providence Co RI) married on 10 Sept 1801 to Rachel Kent (14 Mar 1783 Rehoboth Bristol Co MA d 30 Jul 1858 Pawtucket Providence Co RI).

Daniel served on the alarm caused by the battle of Bunker Hill. He served with Capt. Abiel Clap's company, Col Carpenter's regiment for 34 days. The company marched to RI on 24 July1777.
