Henry Clapper, Pennsylvania, A131542

The earliest record has Henry in the Maryland Census of 1776 as Henry Klaber, age 26 (born 1750). The census shows he was married to Fronica Klaber, Age 17 (born 1759).

Henry served as a Corporal with Captain Daniel Clapsaddle/Clapsadler – 1st Batt. Cumberland County Militia and with Col. James Johnston, 20 Aug 1780 to 27 July 1781.

His records states that he resided in Washington Twp. Cumberland Co. Pennsylvania as a farmer after the war. His first wife died between 1790 and 1800. Later he married Eve Nicewonger. After Henry's death on May 4,1813, Eve continued to farm on their 150 acres until 1828.
