John Marshall, Massachusetts, A073862

- Private; Pension S*W23929
- Residence: Londonderry Rockingham Co NH & Cambridge Middlesex Co MA
- Born: 1756
- Died: 1 Jan 1820 Greenbush Schoharie Co NY

John married Sarah March (c 1760 Newbury MA, d 12 Dec 1853 ME) on 13 Oct 1781 at Londonderry NH. As of Spring 2022, DAR recognizes daughters from their son Daniel.

Daniel (b Sep 1793, d 31 Aug 1858) married Mary E Howard (b Jan 1810, d 27 Sep 1888).
on 1 Oct 1828 at Vasselboro ME.

John enlisted at Cambridge MA on or about 1 May 1775 in a company commanded by Capt. Archelaus Towne in Col Ebenezer Bridge's Regiment. He continued to serve until the last day of Dec 1775 at which time he was discharged. He was in the battle of Bunker Hill which was within the siege of Boston.

He also served an enlistment was in Capt. Benjamin Mann's Co commanded by Col Reed's regiment of the NH line until 1 Jan 1777 when discharged at a place called Mount Independence in VT. Marshall seems to have traveled to many states. However, the state boundaries have moved a bit since this time,
