Stephen Moore, New Jersey, A079937

Stephen was born 1 Dec 1759 in Pennington, NJ. This is just north of Trenton, NJ. He died 20 Jan 1813 at the age of 53 in Chillisquaque Township, Northumberland County, PA which is 175 miles northwest of his birth.

Mr. Moore served as a Private in Captain Philipps Company, 3rd Regiment of the Hunterdon County Militia in 1777 at the age of 18. From April to September 1780, he served as a Wagon Master commanding a brigade of six to eight teams. A Wagon Master is a person who has charge of one or more wagons such as in a military train.

The Wagon Master position is considered Patriotic Service by NSDAR. Moore is also recognized for his Military Service.
