### A MESSAGE FROM OUR NATIONAL CHAIR

It's really hard to believe this is our final issue of the Explorer for the Dillon Administration. What fun we have had on our Exploring Junior Membership journey! Continental Congress will indeed be the ultimate celebration of all that has been accomplished during the past three years.

Forty-seven states earned recognition for 2018 on our States' Honor Roll for Outstanding Support of Junior Membership. A record 29 states achieved Trailblazer status! I am in awe of all that our states continue to accomplish each year in support of Junior Membership and the Helen Pouch Memorial Fund. The following states are to be commended for earning Trailblazer status each year of the Dillon Administration: Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Missouri, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, South Carolina, Tennessee, and Texas. Each of these states will be recognized during the Junior Membership Luncheon at Congress.

A little more than a year ago I secretly set a goal of what I hoped we could raise through the Helen Pouch Memorial Fund this year. I decided not to tell anyone that goal because it was a little crazy, really, I thought, a pipe dream. I am pleased to tell you that we surpassed this goal in our fundraising efforts for 2018 and we will be distributing a RECORD-SHATTERING amount during the Junior Membership Luncheon to the DAR Schools, the 2019 HPMF National Project, Honor Flight Network; 102 classrooms across the country through our Classroom Grant Award Program, and the recipient of the earned interest from the Friends of Junior Membership endowment fund! Be sure to also plan to attend the Junior Membership Forum in the Banquet Hall on Thursday beginning at 4 pm. A light (FREE) dinner will be provided! This is an opportunity to network with other Juniors and supporters from around the country, learn more about the work of the Junior Membership committee, and celebrate our award winners. All are welcome!

It has been such a privilege to serve as the National Chair of Junior Membership during the Dillon Administration. I am so grateful for the dedicated work of the National Vice Chairs and Division Vice Chairs of this committee, they are the best and truly some of the hardest working women I know! The State Chairs of Junior Membership are creative, thoughtful, and enthusiastic. Thank you for your service and leading the Junior Journey in your states. The opportunity to meet and work with Juniors and Junior supporters across the country has been hands-down one of the best parts of this job. # States' Honor Roll for Outstanding Support of Junior Membership

Congratulations to the 47 states who have achieved Trailblazer, Adventurer, and Explorer status in States' Honor Roll for Outstanding Support of Junior Membership! The five standards that states must meet in order to be named to the Honor Roll include: 1) Naming a State Outstanding Junior or at least 2 chapter Outstanding Juniors; 2) Enroll at least 1 new Friend or Best Friend of Junior Membership; 3) Host a Junior event at a state meeting or have a statewide Junior Event open to all Junior members; 4) Have a sales table for Junior Sales Products (ordered from National) at a state meeting and remit profits to the Treasurer General's office; and 5) Have chapters or individuals donate directly to the Helen Pouch Memorial Fund (separate from sales). States meeting all five standards achieved Trailblazer status. States meeting 4 out of 5 standards achieved Adventurer status. States meeting 3 out of 5 standards achieved Explorer status. 
