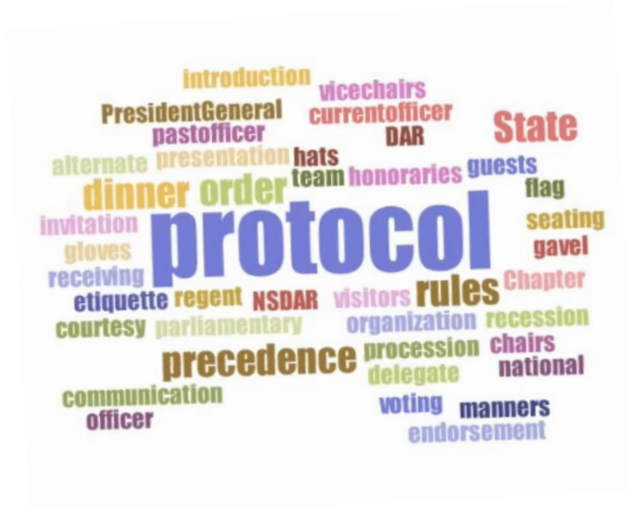


# Protocol Tips in the DAR World

- ★ President General
  - Highest ranking DAR officer
  - Only she speaks on behalf of the National Society
  - Honored guests at all DAR functions
- ★ State Regent
  - Highest ranking DAR state officer
  - Only she speaks on behalf of her State National Society



- ★ Rise to show respect
- ★ Introduce guests in descending order of rank
- ★ There is only one presiding officer; address that person only
- ★ Remove glove from right hand before placing over heart while reciting Pledge of Allegiance & singing the National Anthem.
- ★ Presiding officer will set the example of when to wear gloves while receiving.
- ★ At meals, wait for the presiding officer to raise her fork before you begin to eat.
- ★ Lastly, rely on your common sense & good judgment
