

DAR INSIGNIA TO MARK MEMBER GRAVES

The Historian General has granted permission to chapter regents to authorize the purchase of DAR Insignia grave markers to be placed at the site of the DAR member's interment.

Chapter regents do so [as shown here](#).

A [form requesting permission to mark a member's grave](#) is completed by the member or by a representative of the member if she is deceased, and sent to her chapter. The regent of the member's chapter signs the form verifying that this woman is or was actually a member of DAR. The signed form is sent by the chapter to an [NSDAR-authorized firm](#) to reproduce the DAR insignia.

Once the marker is placed, the chapter is instructed to complete the [DAR Member Grave Marker Report Form](#) and send it to National. The membership file will be updated to record the cemetery location and date the marker was placed.

If a member wishes to have the DAR Insignia etched into the headstone, please forward the request to the Office of the Historian General, so they may send the insignia pattern and instructions for etching.

If membership cannot be verified in the chapter, please forward the request to the Office of the Historian General.
