The trip home will begin after the Sunday morning Memorial service and new officer installation which will be late morning on Sunday. One more treat will be a visit to the house of Benjamin and Caroline Harrison in Indianapolis, Indiana on the way home. There are several special meals, first day dinner, a stop at the Golden Lamb Blackhorse Tavern, the longest continually operating business in Ohio, and a farewell dinner in Champaign, Illinois.
