### Daniel Shaw, Massachusetts, A102040

- Corporal, Pension S\*W19028
- Residence: Ashfield Hampshire Co Massachusetts
- Born: 29 Sep 1742, Bridgewater Plymouth Co Massachusetts
- Died: 20 Sep 1830, Sparta Livingston Co New York

Daniel married Olive Lillie (b 6 Apr 1750 Ashfield MA d 2 May 1837 Sparta NY) on 18 Oct 1770 at Ashfield MA. Their children were Sarah, Zachariah, Olive, Daniel, Mehitable, Samuel, Joseph, Eunice, and John. As of 2021, DAR recognizes daughters from three children, Joseph, Samuel and John.

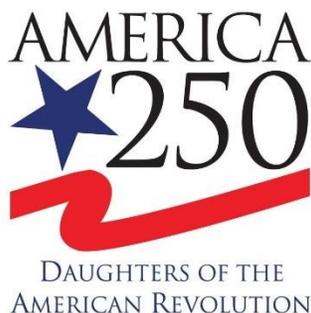
- Joseph (b p31 Dec 1786 Ashfield Springfield MA d p1845 Putnam Co IN) married a1810 to Mary Hume (d c1784, d p1840 IN).
- Samuel (b c1788 NY d 28 Feb 1875 San Pierre IN) in 1811 married Sarah Livings (b 13 Jun 1793 d 11 Sep 1877).
- John (b 17 Sep 1792 Saratoga NY d 8 Sep 1883) married on 3 Jan 1815 to Clarissa Stearns (b 18 Oct 1792 VT d 21 Mar 1863). Clarissa was the daughter of David Stearns, Jr.

Daniel enlisted Feb. 17, 1777, at Ashfield MA and was in battles of Burgoyne, Monmouth and the Siege of St Staunwix. He served in Capt. Samuel Bartletts Company of Col. James Wesson's Regt. He received a State bounty upon discharge Dec. 31, 1779
