Elisha Allen, New York, A001522

- Civil Service
- Residence: Cambridge Dist Albany Co New York
- Born: 7 Sep 1722 Dartmouth Bristol Co MA
- Died: a10 June 1802 Cambridge Washington Co New York

Elisha's parents were Phillip and Mary Allen. Elisha married in 1751 to Elizabeth Fish (b 4 Jun 1736 Dartmouth Bristol Co MA, d a26 Mar 1814 Cambridge Washington Co NY). Elizabeth's parents were Thomas Fish and Mercy Coggeshall Fish. Elisha and Elizabeth had 11 children: John (1752-1825), Gideon (1754-1806), Audra (1759-1810), Mary (1760-?), Lydia (1761-1802), Laban (1762-1802), Waite (1766-1850), Annis (1766-b1802), Elizabeth (1768-b1802), Hannah (1770-1840) and Philip (1777-1842).

As of Spring 2022, DAR recognizes daughters from their child Hannah.

- Hannah (b 1770, d p25 Mar 1814) married c1790 to Christopher Macomber (b c1755, d p1840 Andes Delaware Co NY).

Before the American Revolution, Elisha was a soldier under General James Wolfe at the 1759 Battle of Quebec. During this service he passed through Cambridge, NY and returned there in 1762 and took title to some land.

In 1777, Elisha was named one of six Assessors in Washington Co NY.
