John McCormick, Virginia, A075644

- Private,
- Residence: Berkeley Co VA
- Born: Circa 1750 VA
- Died: After 22 Sep 1822 Jackson Co IN

John married Ann circa 1773. Ann was born in VA and died in Jackson Co IN after 1823.

As of spring, 2021, NSDAR recognizes daughters from four of their children: Hudson, John, Thomas, and Nancy.

- Hudson born circa 1773 in VA and died at Washington Twp Owen Co IN after 12 Aug 1850. He married Jane who was born 1784 in Ireland and died in Owen Co IN on 8 Jun 1848.
- John Jr born 14 Nov 1774 in VA and died in Jackson Co IN on 26 Aug 1845. He married Rebecca Findley who was born on 25 Jan 1802 in KY and died in Jackson Co IN on 28 Apr 1884. They were married on 25 Dec 1823 in IN.
- Thomas born 28 Jul 1778 in PA and died at White Co IN on 28 Oct 1857. He married Elizabeth who was born on 28 Sep 1781 and died in Carroll Co IN on 16 Oct 1836. They were married a.1802.
- Nancy born circa 1795 in VA and died in Washington Twp Owen Co IN on 29 Jun 1854. She married William Lindsey who died in Owen Co IN before 22 Sep 1828.

John Sr. served under Captain John Marks, Colonels Lewis and Davis in the 10th and 14th Regiments of the Virginia Line. Both Regiments were formed in western Virginia and were involved in the Battle of Brandywine, Battle of Germantown, Battle of Monmouth, and Siege of Charleston.

John's residence is listed as Berkeley County, VA (now West Virginia).
