Peter Pence, Pennsylvania, A088292

- Lieutenant
- Residence: Lancaster Co Pennsylvania
- Born: 1742, Lancaster Co Pennsylvania
- Died: a. 12 March 1812, Sugar Creek Twp Armstrong Co Pennsylvania

His first wife's name is not known, yet two children (Jacob and Henry) from that union have been identified. He married Elizabeth Sullenberger (Sullenburger) 17 Jun 1788 in Northeast Madison Township Perry Co PA. They had four children (Mary, Catherine, Peter (b 1806 d 1894), George Washington). As of 2021, DAR recognizes daughters from Jacob, Henry and George.

- Jacob (b 1773 Lancaster Co PA d 28 Oct 1856 Harlensburg Lawrence Co PA) married Ellender Boyd (b 1777 Lancaster Co PA d 6 Dec 1856 Harlensburg Lawrence Co PA).
- Henry (b 1782 PA d 22 May 1837 Redbank Twp Armstrong Co PA) married Elizabeth Gumbert (b 1786 PA d p1850 Clarion Co PA).
- George's (b Oct 1810 Armstrong Co PA d 1 Jun 1906 Wicklow Armstrong Co PA) second wife was Susannah Jack (b 1809 Clarion Co PA d a1906 PA). They married c 1841.

Peter was commissioned 26 Aug 1780 as a Lt. He served the 6th Company with Capt. Philip Peck, 3rd Battalion Lancaster Co PA Militia. Peter also served in Lancaster Co. 10th Battalion and received 400 acres of land.
