Robert Marshall, Pennsylvania, A073940

- Private
- Born: 1745 PA
- Died: Ante 24 Dec 1832 Cross Creek Twp probably Washington Co PA
- Residence: Lancaster Co PA

Robert married Eleanor (Elinor) Hays (b 1769 d 31 Dec 1831 Cross Creek Twp Washington Co PA). Both are buried in the Mt. Prospect Cemetery Hickory PA.

As of Fall 2021, NSDAR recognizes daughters from their daughter Margaret.

- Margaret (b 3 Jan 1794 Cross Creek Village Washington Co PA d 25 Dec 1886 Hartford Warren Co IA) in 1817 married Hance McMeeken (b 5 Oct 1791 Belfast Ireland d 1862 Knoxville Marion Co IA).

Robert served in Capt. Samuel Cocrane's (Cochran) Legion/Company; 10th Battalion of the Lancaster Co PA Militia commanded by Col Robert Eden (Elder). The company was in actual service on 13 Apr 1781. He was one of the 18 men under Col Williamson who formed a second line in favor of saving the Moravian Indians from massacre at Gnadenhutten in 1782.
